Arturo Márquez was born in Sonora, Mexico in 1950. Surrounded by a musical family, Márquez studied composition with the likes of Federico Ibarra, Hector Quintanar, and Joaquín Gutiérrez Heras. Márquez composed eight Danzon works in total, with the second being by far the most popular.

The only widely played danzón for symphony orchestra before this one by Mexican composer Arturo Márquez (b. 1950) is the Danzón Cubano by Aaron Copland. As the title of that work indicates, the danzón is Cuban in origin. It is considered a refined salon dance and counts as its antecedents the habanera and the contra-dance.
