Only Franz Liszt could approach Beethoven's virtuosity, and that was decades after Beethoven's death; Liszt also had the benefit of improved piano technology. Beethoven was most passionate about his sonatas. He kept composing them, 32 in all, long after he stopped composing his more public works such as the five piano concertos and nine symphonies.

Born in Bonn, Beethoven's musical talent was obvious at an early age, and he was initially harshly and intensively taught by his father Johann van Beethoven. Beethoven was later taught by the composer and conductor Christian Gottlob Neefe, under whose tutelage he published his first work, a set of keyboard variations, in 1783. He found relief from a dysfunctional home life with the family of Helene von Breuning, whose children he loved, befriended, and taught piano. At age 21, he moved to Vienna
