The character reference should be signed, dated and include the contact details of the author. A signed character reference gives the court greater confidence the statements are honestly and genuinely made.

Character Reference for Court • Example • Anderson ...

There is no point in writing a character reference for court that refers to the offending as “out of character” if the accused has already done it before. Be very careful when discussing the facts of a case in detail and, if you do, make sure to first read the summary of facts being read to the Judge or Magistrate.

Character Reference letter for Court and templates

For a Local Court, the character reference should be addressed to “The Presiding Magistrate.”. For a District or Supreme Court, address it to “The Presiding Judge.”. The salutation (where you would normally put Dear Sir / Dear Madam) should be “Your Honour.”. The reference should be typed.

Character reference template - Court Character reference

Being involved in a court proceeding is a serious event and therefore the tone of a character reference should reflect this by being honest and formal. The reference should be addressed to the recipient correctly. For example, a case in the Magistrates Court should be addressed to ‘The Presiding Magistrate’ and state the court location.

Do's and Dont's when writing a Character Reference for Court

1. The character reference for Court should be addressed “To the Sentencing Magistrate” or “To the Sentencing Judge”. Who the character reference is addressed to depends on which Court the defendant is going to. If the matter is in Queensland in the Magistrates’ Court the character reference should be headed “To the Sentencing Magistrate”.

How To Write a Character Reference For Court | Potts Lawyers

(It is perfectly acceptable for you to write a court reference for your family member so long as you clearly state that fact that he/she is a family member and your relationship.) Court references are generally used by a Magistrate or Judge to determine the character of the accused at the sentencing.

A character reference is a letter and includes your opinion of this person. The magistrate or judge will read the character reference before deciding what penalty to give. The reference will be more helpful if you have known the person for a long time or you have had lots of contact with them. You must also be of good character and not have been in serious trouble with the police before.

Formatting the Letter: In order to format the character reference letter, include a date at the very top of the letter, write the relevant address, start with “Your Honor,“ and, in the end, sign the reference.

Character Reference Letter for Court (Samples & Templates)
