4.1. Aseptic processing of sterile combination products. Combination products are therapeutic or diagnostic products that combine drugs, devices, and/or biological products. They are defined as two or more separate products packaged together in a single package or as a unit and comprised of drug and device products, device and biological products, or biological and drug products.

Success with Manual Aseptic Processing

Processing lines using not-from-concentrate (NFC) as raw material are shown in lines 3 and 4. Frozen NFC, usually in 200 litre drums, is stored at -18°C. Aseptic bulk NFC, typically in aseptic storage tanks or aseptic bag-in-box containers, is stored at 0°C or higher. NFC preparation. Solid frozen NFC is liquefied before processing.
