Shareholder equity helps you value a company when you use it to figure out book value. Book value is literally the value of a company that can be found on the accounting ledger. To calculate book value per share, take a company's shareholder's equity and divide it by the current number of shares outstanding.

## Giddy: Methods of Corporate Valuation

Profit Multiplier. In profit multiplier, the value of the business is calculated by multiplying its profit. For example, if your company's adjusted net profit is \$100,000 per year, and you use a multiple like 4, then the value of the business will be calculated as  $4 \times \$100,000 = \$400,000$ .
