Mediation Arbitration Negotiation is a process where two parties in a conflict or dispute (fight) reach a settlement between themselves that they can both agree on.

Mediation and negotiation are very similar to each other, as they both culminate from the point of goals of the parties: the parties always decide on the outcome itself. The purpose of mediation is to keep the outcome in the hands of the parties but in order to reach an agreement, the procedure might need a little formality as bilateral negotiations are easily jammed if the parties start to search for a “guilty” party and not solve the problem.

Difference Between Negotiation and Mediation | Compare the ...

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In a successful negotiation, the parties and their negotiators reach a resolution of the dispute based on the parties' interests. Mediation is often referred to as “assisted negotiation.” In this process, the parties select a neutral person, the mediator, to help them arrive at a settlement of the dispute.

Using Negotiation, Mediation and Arbitration to Resolve ...

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Mediation does result in binding agreements, based on the parties' mediated discussions. However, binding areements resulting from litigations or arbitrations which are settled are not as frequently complied with as agreements reached after mediation. There is yet a fourth method of dispute resolution not mentioned here.

The departure of divisive leaders on one side of the conflict or the other can offer new hope for resolution after some time has passed. Take advantage of such changes by making a new settlement proposal, working through a mediator or other third party if necessary (see also, The Right Time to Negotiate).

3 Negotiation Strategies for Conflict Resolution

Conflict resolution can refer to any type of alternative bargaining done between two sides outside of the courtroom. In addition to mediation, conflict resolution can also be obtained through arbitration, which is a binding form of judgment that is often faster and less expensive than a traditional trial.

Dispute resolution generally refers to one of several different processes used to resolve disputes between parties, including negotiation, mediation, arbitration, collaborative law, and litigation. Dispute resolution is the process of resolving a dispute or a conflict by meeting at least some of each side's needs and addressing their interests.

An often-overlooked alternative dispute resolution process is med-arb, a mediation-arbitration hybrid. In med-arb, disputants hire a neutral mediator. If she is unable to resolve the dispute through mediation, she puts on her arbitration hat and renders a decision, explains Sander.
