Use myself to refer back to the subject of the sentence (it is a reflexive pronoun). I gave myself a bunch of flowers for my birthday. Do not use myself as a substitute for I or me. For instance, don't say: Please send this to myself. (incorrect) You can also use myself as an intensifier. I myself don't like knitting.
