“Jesus Heals the Lame Man At Bethesada” John 5:1-18. It must be pointed out that all of the healing miracles of Jesus do not fit into a neat pattern. In the last miracle we examined (Luke 5:18-26), the friends of an invalid broke through a roof to let him down into the presence of Jesus. He appears to be healed on the basis of the faith of his friends.

In Acts 3, Peter and John heal a man who was lame from birth. There are three ways to look at the miracle of this passage. First, we can look at the man himself. Over 40 years old (Acts 4:22), he was doubt- less a pitiable sight.

We are not told which festival, but some scholars believe it to be the Feast of Tabernacles. While in Jerusalem, Jesus visits the pool of Bethesda (see model below). The pool is where blind, lame, and paralyzed people would go to seek healing. At the pool, Jesus finds a man who has been an invalid for thirty-eight years.

Commentary on John 5 (Jesus Heals at the Pool of Bethesda ...

Jesus knew that the man was a sinner, like every man, woman, and child. Jesus knew that the man was separated from God because of his sin (Isaiah 59:2). A person who is separated from God is the saddest sight in the world! Because the men fully trusted Jesus, Jesus gave this man the greatest gift. It was FAR better than making his legs work; it was the forgiveness of his sins. And when Jesus forgave the man's sins, he became a part of God's kingdom.

6. Jesus Heals the Paralyzed Man (Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:1 ...

Second, Jesus said nothing to him about his faith healing him as He often did with others. And third, the lame man had no idea who Jesus was, even after he'd been healed. When he first conversed with Jesus, he wasn't looking to Him as someone who could heal him. In his mind, Jesus was no different than any other person present.

1. Why did Jesus heal the man who was lame? Prompt kids to recognize that the man did not ask for healing. He had been disabled a long time and seemed hopeless. The man did not even recognize Jesus, but Jesus showed compassion to the man and healed him—instantly and completely. The man experienced Jesus' power.
