Minibeasts are invertebrates – they are creatures without backbones. So that includes insects, spiders, beetles, snails, worms, centipedes... the list goes on. In fact, there are about 25,000 different types of invertebrate living in the UK, and around 20,000 of these are types of insect. Because invertebrates don't have a skeleton inside their body, some live in shells (like snails, for example), and others, such as beetles, have a hard covering called an 'exoskeleton'.
