Less is more, so speak in chunks. If you have a lot to say, use several short sentences with pauses in between, rather than one long, drawn out sentence. Speaking concisely and in chunks facilitates comprehension and decreases stress for your English language learners because they have fewer words to process at a time.

English-Language Learners Need More Support During Remote ...

Post the daily schedule and keep it as constant as possible. Use specific morning routines, such as lunch count, turning in homework, putting things away, morning greetings, ect. Use predictable signals for getting student attention, transitions, lining up, ect. Use predictable procedures for passing

out materials.
