Filmmakers—from students to amateurs to professionals—submitted 10-minute films based on the lives of members of Minnesota's "Greatest Generation". At a film festival each October, \$10,000 was awarded to five films in various categories.

MPEG-1 (1993): Coding of moving pictures and associated audio for digital storage media at up to about 1.5 Mbit/s (ISO/IEC 11172). This initial version is known as a lossy fileformat and is the first MPEG compression standard for audio and video. It is commonly limited to about 1.5 Mbit/s although the specification is capable of much higher bit rates.
