'The Manhunt (Laura's Poem)' Analysis "the frozen river which ran through his face" The adjective "frozen" emphasises the permanent physical scarring on the man's face, which in turn reflects the pain and brutality of war, in particular the harsh impact it has had on the soldier's appearance.

The "manhunt" of the poem's title is a reference to the speaker's exploration of her husband's dramatically changed body and self, and the poem demonstrates the difficulty of reconnecting with loved ones after they've returned from traumatic military combat.
