STEVENS ARMS CO., J. In 1864, this firm began doing business as J. Stevens & Company. In 1888, it was incorporated as J. Stevens Arms & Tool Company. It operated as such until 1920, when it was taken over by Savage Arms Company. It has operated as an independent division in this organization since. This company produced a great many firearms—most that were of an affordable nature.

In 1916-20 Savage bought the J. Stevens Arms Co. which had been associated with Harry Pope, the barrel maker. In 1927 Savage bought the Page-Lewis Company. Later, Davis-Warner was bought by HD Folsom then traded as Davis- Crescent (Crescent was created out of the Beacon Arms Co.- 1892) and in 1932 was bought by Stevens .

Enter Joshua Stevens. Born in 1814 and professionally associated as a master machinist and toolmaker for Cyrus B. Allen of Springfield, Massachusetts, Samuel Colt, Edward Wesson and the Massachusetts Arms Co., Joshua Stevens was 50 years old when he filed his patent in 1864 for a breech loading tip-up action that would launch the J. Stevens Arms & Tool Co.

By 1902, J. Stevens and Company was one of the top firearms manufacturers in the world. With the merger of Savage Arms and J. Stevens and Company in 1920, the company, of course, grew to become the largest manufacturer of firearms at the time. By 1915, the company opened offices in New York, London, Australia, the Caribbean, and Latin America.

Stevens Arms was an American firearms manufacturer founded by Joshua Stevens in 1864 in Chicopee, Massachusetts. The company introduced the .22 Long Rifle round and made a number of rifle, shotgun, and target pistol designs. The Stevens Model 520 was a pump-action shotgun developed by John Browning and originally manufactured by the J Stevens Arms & Tool Company between 1909 and 1916. Stevens was sold to New England Westinghouse on 28 May 1915 and production of civilian firearms was greatly reduced. The company was renamed the "J Stevens Arms Company" on 1 July 1916 and New England Westinghouse used their manufacturing facility in Chicopee Falls, MA to produce Mosin-Nagant rifles under contract for the Russian Czar

Founder Joshua Stevens was a New England toolmaker who had gained experience in firearms manufacture while employed at various times by C. B. Allen, Eli Whitney, Samuel Colt, and Edwin Wesson.
